IEA 2012 – Final Paper

Abstract. This paper describes the Feedback method designed to collect the contribution of users for the reconstruction and comprehension of the actual work and real activity for the improvement of the technical standards, design, manufacturing and use of machinery. The Feedback method has since now been applied successfully - in collaboration with public authorities, market surveillance bodies, social partners organization and technical institutes - to five different types of machines: woodworking machinery, forklift trucks, angle grinder and combine harvester. After ten years of experimentation in seven European countries Feedback has proved to be trans-nationally comparable and has attracted the interest of as much as 250 expert users - mostly workers, but also employers and technicians - who have shared their knowledge and experience by taking part in almost 30 working groups. The information collected with the Feedback method can be used by:

- CEN and ISO standardization committees and working groups to become aware of the problems relating to the real use of specific machines in different work contexts, and thus to be able to draw up new or to revise existing standards accordingly;
- Designers and manufacturers to produce better, more comfortable and safer machines and to provide precise instructions for use;
- Employers, users and workers for training purposes and for defining appropriate work procedures;
- Inspection bodies to enhance their knowledge and improve the efficiency of their interventions and advice.

Touch-screen tablet user configurations and case-supported tilt affect head and neck flexion angles

Abstract. Objective: The aim of this study was to determine how head and neck postures vary when using two media tablet (slate) computers in four common user configurations.

Methods: Fifteen experienced media tablet users completed a set of simulated tasks with two media tablets in four typical user configurations. The four configurations were: on the lap and held with the user's hands, on the lap and in a case, on a table and in a case, and on a table and in a case set at a high angle for watching movies. An infra-red LED marker based motion analysis system measured head/neck postures. Results: Head and neck flexion significantly varied across the four configurations and across the two tablets tested. Head and neck

flexion angles during tablet use were greater, in general, than angles previously reported for desktop and notebook computing. Postural differences between tablets were driven by case designs, which provided significantly different tilt angles, while postural differences between configurations were driven by gaze and viewing angles. Conclusion: Head and neck posture during tablet computing can be improved by placing the tablet higher to avoid low gaze angles (i.e. on a table rather than on the lap) and through the use of a case that provides optimal viewing angles.

Health Council of the Netherlands. Standing, kneeling and squatting, work. The Hague: Health Council of the Netherlands, 2011; publication, no. 2011/41.

In the present report, at the request of the Minister of Social Affairs and Employment, the Health Council of the Netherlands has investigated whether at the present time there are any new scientific insights concerning health-based or safety-based limit values for work performed while standing, kneeling or squatting.

This report is one of a series of advisory reports in which the Committee on the Identification of Workplace Risks examining occupational risks covered by the Dutch Working Conditions Act and its associated regulations. To answer the Minister's questions, the Committee studied the scientific data on adverse health effects of working in standing, kneeling or squatting position, and considered the results of longitudinal studies to be particularly important, as they involve the least likelihood of bias.

On the basis of the available scientific data, the Committee concluded that it is not possible to indicate a safe level below which no adverse health effects would be expected for people who work in standing, kneeling or squatting position. However, it was possible to obtain information on the extent of the risks of lower-back complaints arising from either working in standing position or working in squatting position.
